<p>3. Perform stockpile operations.</p> <p>3.1. Remove coal from predetermined stockpile location in accordance with work specifications Refers to the CHPP wash plan for stockpile dozer requirements Communicates with the CHPP Control Room operator prior to entry to stockpile to confirm tripper location Uses correct techniques to reclaim coal for train loading (slot dozing working from front to back and no deeper than the blade) Maintains a blade of coal at the valve edge and pushes the first blade full in with the next Ensures that no voids or drop offs are left on the stockpile on completion of train loading</p>	Competent
<p>4. Carry out operator maintenance.</p> <p>4.1. Prepare machine for maintenance. Sets machine up for maintenance, i.e.; Parked on level ground in a safe location, positioned correctly, Shut down etc. Organises track / undercarriage cleaning when required.</p>	Competent
